PROPOSAL FOR A SPECIAL TRACK

TECH-EDU 2022 special tracks are sessions organized by high-profile organizers that invite 5-6 authors in a special podium session as part of the conference program. They intend to extend the impact of the conference and promote its main goals, namely: innovative technologies that incorporate specific affordances that may be used both in the teaching and learning processes; theoretical, technological, pedagogical, organizational, instructional, as well as policy issues regarding technologies and innovation in education; to share experiences and best practices. Outlined below are the guidelines for organizing and submitting a special track.

Proposal submission

- In order to submit a special track proposal, please email the “Special Track Proposal Form” to TECH-EDU 2022 organizing committee at specialtrack@tech-edu.ws.
- The special track organizer may use the TECH-EDU 2022 website to call for paper submissions. When a proposal is accepted, the special session organizer will be informed of the designated weblink. The organizer’s name will appear in the conference program as “Special Track Organizer.” • Additionally, each Special Track Organizer will receive ONE free full registration for TECH-EDU 2022.
- For a session to be considered as a TECH-EDU 2022 special track, it must include a minimum of 5 papers.
- Special tracks proposals should be submitted until **January 28, 2022**.
- Special tracks organizers will be notified of acceptance until **March 5, 2022**.

Paper submission

- All papers for the special track will be submitted directly to the organizer.
- No special track papers are to be submitted through the TECH-EDU 2022 website.

Paper revision and selection

- The special track organizer is responsible for having each paper reviewed by at least two independent reviewers.
- The special track organizer will make the final selection of papers for the session.
- The special track organizer must email all accepted authors information to specialtrack@techedu.ws, by the general notification deadline. TECH-EDU 2022 organization committee will then send official invitation letters and registration information to the authors.
- All authors accepted for the special track are required to register and provide full payment by the conference registration deadline.
- All final papers must be received by the conference final submission deadline and must adhere to the TECH-EDU 2022 final paper formatting requirements outlined at the conference web site at <http://tech-edu.ws/2022/>
- The special track organizer will act as chairman of the special track at the conference.
- The special track organizer's paper can be reviewed by TECH-EDU 2022 scientific committee upon request.
